Day 3 Read Daniel 6:3-28

1. Look up Satraps. What does it mean?
2. Why do you think the other leader's tried to find charges against Daniel?
3. Were they successful in finding anything corrupt against him?
4. Similarly, the media has tried to find anything corrupt about Tim Tebow. If someone were looking to find something corrupt about you, would they be successful?
5. What did Daniel do after the king issued the edict against prayer?
6. If there were laws against Christianity, what would you do?

2. What do you think is the purpose of this passage?
3. What were the motives of the Pharisees for all their public activities?
