

**"JUST SAY KNOW" BIBLE STUDY**  
**The Wilderness Will Rejoice and Blossom**

**Day 1 Read Ecclesiastes 3:1-11**

This is a popular passage with a wonderful promise.

1. Do you think Solomon gave an accurate portrayal of life in this passage?
2. Does knowing that every activity is just for a season bring encouragement to you? What season do you find yourself in today?
3. What is the great promise of this passage? Do you believe it? Why or Why not?

**Day 2 Read Isaiah 35:1-10**

This chapter is entitled The Joy of the Redeemed. If we are part of the redeemed then this word is for you!

List the promises in this chapter.

**Day 3 Read Jeremiah 17:5-8**

This passage encourages us not to put our trust in man but in God.

1. What is the curse when we put our trust in man rather than God?
2. What is the blessing when we put our trust in God?
3. How are they similar? How are they different? What does this passage tell us we all will encounter in life?

**Day 4 Read Isaiah 41:17-20; 43:18-21**

Here we are told God is doing a new thing. Apparently we can miss it if we aren't paying attention!

1. Why does God like to use desert experiences?
2. According to Isaiah 43, where is God going to do a new thing?
3. What does God promise to provide? To whom will he provide it? For what reason?

**Day 5 Read Deuteronomy 2:7; Nehemiah 9:19-21**

There are many desert/wilderness references in the Bible. If you are going through a wilderness time in your life, be encouraged. This is where God does His most amazing work!

1. Name as many Bible characters as you can that had desert/wilderness experiences. (Hint: You can just type in desert or wilderness in any of the Bible Study tools on the website.)
2. Did the Israelites lack anything while they traveled through the desert?
3. How did God provide for the Israelites when they were in the desert?
