

"JUST SAY KNOW" BIBLE STUDY
Sacred Honor

The Westminster Catechism asks "What is the chief and highest end of man?" The answer, "Man's chief and highest end is to glorify God, and fully to enjoy him forever." We are here to bring honor and glory to God. This week, we'll see what the Bible says about honor.

Day 1 Read 1 Samuel 2:30; 1 Chronicles 29:12; Proverbs 21:21, 18:12

1. What is God's promise to us if we honor Him?
2. According to Proverbs 21:21, what must we pursue to find honor?
3. According to Proverbs 18:12, what comes before honor?
4. Journal a time when you honored God and He honored you in return.

Day 2 Read Isaiah 29:13-16; Matthew 15:8-9

1. What does it mean to just honor God with our lips?
2. Have you ever honored God with your lips but your heart was far from him? Explain.

Day 3 Read Daniel 5:1-31

One of the ways we dishonor God is through our pride. Check out this story in Daniel!

1. The gold and silver goblets were from the Holy Temple that Solomon built for God. Why would drinking out of them bring God's judgment on Belshazzar?
2. What else did they do to incur God's judgment?
3. Have you ever wondered where the term "The handwriting on the wall" came from? What did the fingers write? What did it mean?
4. What happened to Belshazzar's father when he became prideful? What happened to him?

Day 4 Read 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19-20

1. But seriously, did you know your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit?
2. Who bought you? What was the price that was paid?
3. How can we honor God with our bodies?

Day 5 Read Revelations 4:9-11, 5:11-14, 7:9-12

In the book of Revelation we get a true understanding of the honor that our God deserves.

1. In these passages, what is God worthy to receive?
2. What has God done in your life to receive honor and glory?
3. List who is doing the worshipping in each of the above passages.
