Day 1 Read Mark 6:35-44

1. Why would Jesus ask the disciples to feed the crowd knowing they could not?
2. What did Jesus have the disciples do to assist in feeding the crowd?
3. What was Jesus' role in meeting the need?
4. How many basketfuls were left over? Do you think this number is significant? Why?
5. Were the people still hungry after they ate?

Day 2 Read John 6:5-13

1. Why did Jesus ask Phillip where they could find food?
2. Have you ever been in an impossible situation? Could it have been a test?
3. What did Jesus use to perform this miracle?
4. If you were there, would you have given all you had like the young boy?
5. Could this passage apply to us today? How?

Day 3 Read John 6:24-35

1. According to this passage, why did the crowd follow Jesus?
2. Do you think people still follow Jesus for what they can get from him?
3. What is more important than temporal food?
4. What is the work that God requires?
5. Who is the bread of God?
6. What does Jesus promise if you come to him? If you believe in him?
7. Is this a literal 'hungry' or 'thirsty'?

Day 4 Read Matthew 15:32-38

1. What motivated Jesus to feed the people?
2. Since this miracle occurred after the feeding of the five thousand, why did the disciples ask this question, "Where could we get enough bread in this remote place to feed such a crowd?"
3. Name at least 3 similarities from this passage to the feeding of the five thousand.

Day 5 Read Mark 8:10-20

1. Why would the disciples be worried about not having bread?
2. Do you think Jesus was worried about them not having bread?
3. What do you think the disciples still did not understand?
4. Have you ever doubted God even after He provided for you?
