Day 1 Read 1 Chronicles 29:11-12; Psalm 24:1; 115:3; 135:6;

1. What do these scriptures teach us about *God*?
2. What belongs to the Lord?
3. Does this bring you peace? Why or why not?

Day 2 Read Psalms 37:23, 139:1-16; Proverbs 16:4, 20:24; Luke 12:6,7

1. How do these verses describe *God's* involvement in your life?
2. According to these scriptures, what does *God* know about you?
3. How does knowing this about *God* affect you?

Day 3 Read about Genesis 24:1-27

1. What did Abraham ask his servant to do?
2. What did the servant do when he reached his destination?
3. What were the signs that he asked *God* to show him so he would know he had found the right wife for Isaac?
4. When did *God* answer the servant's prayer?

Day 4 Read Genesis 24:28-67

1. Why was Abraham's servant in a hurry to return home?
2. Do you think Rebekah's family would have supported the marriage if *God* had not providentially arranged the meeting?
3. Did anyone question whether this was the will of *God*?
4. Can you think of a time when *God* providentially directed you?

Day 5 Read Exodus 1:8-22; 2:1-10

1. Why did Pharaoh order all the Hebrew baby boys to be killed?
2. Who did *God* providentially arrange to protect the Hebrew baby boys?
3. Who found the baby Moses in the river?
4. Was this a coincidence that Moses' mother was hired to nurse the baby?
5. What benefits would Moses have being raised in the Pharaoh's household?
