3. According to verse 10, what should never be forsaken? Why?

**Day 3 Read 2 Samuel 13:1-14; Deuteronomy 13:6-11**

Unfortunately, some of us have 'supposed friends' that mislead us. The Bible gives some examples of this.

1. In the first passage, how did Ammon's friend lead him astray?
2. How might things have been different if Ammon had a godly friend?
3. Have you ever had friends pressure you into doing the wrong things? When?
4. In the Deuteronomy passage, why do you think the punishment was so harsh for those doing the misleading?

**Day 4 Read Proverbs 17:17; 18:24**

The love of a true friend is constant.

1. List some times when a friend came through for you when things were very difficult.
2. List some times when you came through for someone else when things were difficult.
3. Is there any acquaintances that you are aware of that need you to be there friend?

**Day 5 Read John 15:12-15**
