Day 1 Read Psalm 148:1-14

Throughout the Bible everyone and everything is beckoned to praise God.

1. Who and what is called to praise God in this passage?
2. How can an inanimate object praise?
3. Do you see an order of progression here? What is it?
4. Why do you think Man is mentioned last?

Day 2 Read Psalm 66:1-8

In this passage, the psalmist invites us to make God's praise glorious.

1. What does the psalmist use to inspire us to praise?
2. What are some things God has done for man? For you personally?
3. To what does verse 6 refer?

Day 3 Read Psalm 19:1-6

Again we see a call to praise God based on His creating the majestic earth.

1. How do you think creation declares the glory of God?
2. How does it "pour forth speech"?
3. What does creation say to you about God?

Day 4 Read 1 Psalm 8:1-9

The Palmist here and in all the Psalms clearly is calling us to praise the Creator and not the creation.

1. Why do you think people worship the creation rather than the creator?
2. When you consider the vastness of the universe, does it surprise you that God cares for you?
3. What is man's place on earth?
4. What responsibility does that bring with it?

Day 5 Read Psalm 139:13-16

This is one of my favorite passages of scripture! From it we learn that God is omniscient, omnipotent and omnipresent. He knows us very intimately.

1. David has realized that of all things created, man is God's greatest and most important. How should this affect the way we live our lives?
2. What are some things in God's creation that amaze you?
