

"JUST SAY KNOW" BIBLE STUDY

What Would You Do?

Day 1 Judges 6:1-40

This passage is about God's call to Gideon.

1. Why did God allow the Midianites to ravage Israel?
2. Have you ever complained about something but didn't want to be part of the solution? (Verses 12-15)
3. How many signs does God give to Gideon? What are they?
4. What would you do if you were asked to do something so far above your capabilities?

Day 2 Read Judges 7:1-25

God gives Gideon a huge job to do and asks him to complete it in an unusual way.

1. What did God say to Gideon when he shows up with all his men to fight? Why?
2. Do the math. How many men did Gideon send away? Would you follow the instructions for the elimination process let alone go to war with so few men?
3. What did Gideon use to defeat the Midianites? How did God intervene?

Day 3 Read Job 1:1-22; 2:1-10

Job is one of the most amazing people in the Bible in my opinion!

1. Could Satan mess with Job without God's permission?
2. List what the four messengers told Job had happened. What was His response?
3. Satan goes back again for permission to mess with Job's health and God gave him what limitation?
4. How did Job respond to these afflictions? How did his wife respond? What would you do?

Day 4 Read Job 42:10-17

The story of Job ends with the fulfillment of God's recompense.

1. Do the math. Go back to Chapter one and compare the number of children, sheep, camels, oxen and donkeys Job had at the beginning with what he had at the end. List them.
2. What did God say to Job's "friends"? Does this make you more careful about what you say?
3. Read verse 12. Does this encourage you?

Day 5 Read Matthew 19:16-29

1. Does Jesus rebuke Peter for asking what he will get for leaving everything for Christ?
2. What does Jesus promise both now and in eternity if we give up everything to follow Him?
